Campus Student Safety Grant Program Questions received as of January 15, 2025

For a university that has multiple campuses (or branch campuses), does each location submit their own grant request or do we submit as a single entity with a line-by-line explanation showing which item/expense would be assigned to a specific location/campus? Response: Institutions can determine whether to submit one proposal that includes several campuses/locations or to submit individual proposals for each campus/location. However, the maximum base award per proposal is \$25,000.

## "Maximum Base Award per Institution" is \$25,000 per proposal. To clarify, is that a maximum of \$25,000 per location/branch, per grant application, or per line item?

Response: The maximum base award per proposal (application) is \$25,000.

## Are indirect costs allowed?

Response: No, indirect costs are not allowed.

The ODHE safety grants team received inquiries pertaining to individual projects. It is not possible for our team to answer specific questions regarding the eligibility of proposed projects. For information regarding authorized equipment, please refer to the authorized equipment list attached to the Campus Student Safety Grant Program RFP.

Each project will be assessed by the proposal submitted and the problem demonstrated as it relates to the purpose of the Campus Student Safety Grant Program. Through the Campus Student Safety Grant Program, ODHE seeks proposals from state institutions of higher education and private nonprofit institutions of higher education to enhance security measures on their campus and increase student safety. ODHE will prioritize funding institutions that demonstrate increased threats of violent crime, terror attacks, hate crimes, or harassment towards students and student organizations.
